



8th-Grade Year-Long "Contract for Success"

Overview: During the 2017-2018 school year, 8th-grade students will be required to earn points in order to participate in quarterly--as well as year-end--rewards and celebrations. This point system is an opportunity for students to track their own progress and success while recognizing individualized achievements.

Specifics: Points can be earned (or deducted) due to student performance in the following areas: academics, school attendance, and behavior. If a student is unable to meet the required number of points in a given quarter or by the end of the year, he/she will be ineligible to participate in the designated rewards and celebrations.

Instructions: Review the following list of rules and expectations with your family. Then sign and return the bottom portion only to your H.I.V.E. teacher no later than **Friday, August 25, 2017.**

Quarterly-Reward Minimum: 12 Points per Quarter
